3	SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF RATE OF SUICIDE AMONG COVERED
4	RESERVES IN NATIONAL VETERAN SUICIDE
5	PREVENTION ANNUAL REPORTS.
6	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-
7	fairs, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, shall
8	include the rate of suicide among covered Reserves in each
9	National Veteran Suicide Prevention Annual Report of the
10	Office Mental Health and Suicide Prevention of the De-
11	partment (or any successor document).
12	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
13	(1) The terms "active military, naval, air, or
14	space service" and "reserve component" have the
15	meanings given such terms in section 101 of title 38,
16	United States Code.
17	(2) The term "covered Reserve" means a
18	former member of a reserve component of one of the
19	Armed Forces who did not serve in the active mili-
20	tary, naval, air, or space service.
